3. Parent proposal for STEM curriculum at Eastlake: presentation offered by Kira Cook
Proposal remove Meet the Masters and put in STEM as 6th rotation
Model after Daybreak Elementary mystery science program is free
Dream Invent Create 2nd option cost money over \$1300.00
two aides, 17-20, \$440 per month aid salary
Lakeshore chain reaction kit \$300 one time fee
Aide at Daybreak: \$100-200 month used for supplies
LiveDaybreak has provided basic materials
State provides stem bus K-3rd grade 30 minute session, 2 hour training older classes
Professionals in the community want to participate we could also run an after school stem

Review budget for the year, and leftover money
2017-2018 allocated \$100K
Remaining balance as of 3/8/18 \$59,843
Anticipating end of the year with \$10k left -
majority of funds used to pay paraprofessionals for interventions
 - a. Reviewed 2017 School Improvement plan including math and reading goals, DIBELS report, and subject matter benchmarks
 - b. Budget summary \$100k:
17 hr assistants: PE, radkids, meet the masters, computers, rover aides, more in 1st grade chinese, teacher signup for rover aides, if aides are used (demand is created) then more aides can be supplied
BTS art teacher 80/20 grant art coincides with CORE standards
 - c. Suggestion: schedule aides for specific class time for math and reading so teachers can rely upon aides in set schedule each day
 - d. Discussion: request for more recess aides, review grade level aide rotation
