3. Set Meeting dates for the rest of the school year

4. Approve Safe Walking Route
 - a. Due in January – will revisit

5. Approve School Improvement Plan – Suzie Williams slide show presentation
 - a. School summary
 - i. Nine teacher online & approximately 20% of students online – just under 800 students in bldg
 - ii. Five new/transferred teachers
 - iii. 1st/2nd grade split created to accommodate a larger 2nd grade
 - iv. 5th grade class being added
 - v. Students are wearing masks – 1 exemption and 1 accommodation
 - b. Literacy Goals & Action Steps
 - i. USBE Required Goal: 60% of all students in 1-3 make typical or better progress as measured by Acadience
 - ii. Kindergarten: Maintain the percentage of students proficient on DIBELS composite from beginning of year to end of year

- iii. 1st grade: reduce percentage scoring well-below by 44%
- iv. 2nd grade: reduce percentage scoring well-below by 25%
- v. 3rd grade: reduce percentage scoring well-below by 34%
- vi. Increase the rigor phonemic awareness with Heggerty
- vii. Use Early Literacy Software (Lexia) to identify specific skill deficits and provide small group instruction to address specific skills
- viii. Use 95% Group Phonics Routine Card for grade 3-6
- ix. Use 95% Group Inc in schools as social distancing allows
- c. Math & Language Arts
 - i. ELA 4th-6th 60% of students proficient in SRI by end of year
 - ii. Every student make one year's growth pre to post test
 - iii. 3rd-6th encouraged to use Mad Dog Math to help achieve this goal
- d. Creating a safe and production school culture
 - i. Second Step Grand – This is a research-based social/emotional learning program. Teachers have received instruction on teaching this program and it is now one of our rotations
 - ii. Golden Gate Kids – Character Ed Rotation
 - iii. radKIDS – Character Ed
 - iv. PBIS Reward – recognize and encourage positive behavior
 - v. Follow school-wide behavior plans with expectation and discipline referral matrix
- e. Strengthen PLC/Collaboration time
 - i. Continue PLC work including professional development with identifying power standards and unpacking them as a team.
 - ii. Defining success criteria
 - iii. RTI strategies and grouping techniques with Solution Tree
 - iv. Weekly professional development at the team level and school-wide level.

- b. Piper would like to see these funds distributed to Jackie for art – no dissent Ü
- c. Valerie suggested we develop a “perk” for our teachers and staff as a way to boost morale which will directly impact classroom morale.
 - i. Possibly asking for sponsors from the community businesses
 - ii. Run it like Teacher Appreciation Week all year. Split months to highlight parts of teachers and staff each month as follows:
 1. September – teachers
 2. October – Admin Staff
 3. November – custodial
 4. December – teachers etc
